Computers, Flat Screen Monitors, Printers, Keyboards, Mice, Copy/Scanners/Fax Machines, Telephones, Battery Back UPS, Cell Phones, Chargers, Accessories, Digital Cameras. Memory Cards, Wire, Cords, Cables, Metal Household Appliances, Ink/Toner Cartridges

<b>BIN TYPES</b>	<b>WHAT GOES</b>	<b>GUIDELINES</b>
Newspaper / Phonebooks	Newspaper, flyers, inserts, phonebooks	No plastic or paper bags. Remove phonebook covers, covers are boxboard.
Magazines / Catalogs Brochures / Calendars	Most types of shiny, heavily inked, slippery paper	No plastic wrapping, rubber bands or cardboard.
Cardboard *Must be flattened	Cardboard boxes, sheets, packaging. Brown packing paper and paper bags	Clean dry materials only. Remove all plastic and styrofoam.
Boxboard / Paperboard	Thin, lightweight paperboard boxes or cartons such as for cereals or shoes.	Clean dry materials only. Flatten large boxes.
Sorted Office Paper (mostly used by businesses)	Copy paper, ledger paper, notepad paper, white envelopes.	NO newspaper, magazines, boxboard, cardboard, manila files, orange envelopes, hanging file folders. Clean/Dry paper only.
Junk Mail / Junk Paper	All kinds of paper that can't be sorted into other listed categories.	Clean dry materials only. All other listed types of paper must be sorted out.
Plastics #1 and #2	Look on bottom of plastic items for the recycling symbol with number 1 & 2. NO plastic grocery bags.	Remove all plastic lids/caps and RINSE CLEAN!!!! No food, oil, soap residue, no dirt. Please, we hate mice, fungus and yucky smells as much as you do!
Aluminum	Cans, Foil and Foil Pans	No liquid or food residue. * No pay
Scrap Metal	Food cans, metal lids, metal appliances. All items that are mostly metal.	No food residue, wood, plastic, glass, aerosol cans, propane tanks. * No pay
